ABOUT GAV

Gyan Anant Vidyalaya was conceptualized and realized in 2020 as one of the two educational projects by the Mobius Foundation group to impart knowledge in an environmentally sustainable approach.

Located in the rural area of Hapur, near Village Atrouli, the school boasts a diverse design. The school reflects its unique aim of instilling, inspiring, and addressing the crucial yet arduous task of environmental responsibility.

Gyan Anant Vidyalaya instills education in rural areas by raising awareness about environmental issues. A school is a place that inculcates values and skills to ensure a well-rounded and holistic development in children. Taking an example from nature, it sows new ideas that germinate and develop roots, growing tall and sturdy in the face of adversity. It is a one-of-a-kind space that encompasses the entire universe of knowledge. School addresses an environment in which creative minds congregate, interact with one another, and construct visions of new realities. Many notions of truth and wisdom are challenged and imbibed in this pursuit of knowledge.

As part of this approach, GAV has a diverse design that reflects its unique historical and socio-cultural settings. Besides following the CBSE curriculum, at GAV, we cover various issues such as climate change, renewable energy, recycling, and sustainability. By focusing on the innate strengths of each child and nurturing their social and creative intelligence the school aspires to raise individuals who are curious, creative, reflective, purposeful, responsible, resilient, and self-assured.

GAV was established in the heart of the rural area with this noble thought and aim of our chairman, Mr. Pradeep Burman, to reach out to every threshold and educate the children while promoting sustainable living and environmental protection.

It takes sweat, perseverance, and hard effort for a desire to become a reality; it doesn't happen by magic. By offering a high-quality education and supporting each element of students' lives, our school is gradually moving closer to achieving excellence, which is both our purpose and mission.

GAV started out with only 66 pupils, but we are happy to report that in just three years, that number has expanded enormously. We are confident that this trip will carry on incessantly until we achieve our goal.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

The main objectives of "GAV" are to promote academic excellence and a passion for learning. We are working hard to achieve our objectives in the most efficient manner feasible. In the 2022–23 school year, out of 264 pupils in grades 3–8, 21 students achieved a score of 90% or higher, 87 students scored 60-80%, 58 students scored 50-60%, 35 students scored 40-50%, below 40% were 25 students.

- ★ 4 Students of class III procured Gold medal in SOF International General Knowledge Olympiad held in the month of November.
- ★ On June 9, 2022, the Science Olympiad Foundation held a mathematical competition in which Master Dakshesh Garg and **Ayushman Dhillon** from **class III** won the gold medal.
- ★ **Vihaan Agarwal** of **Grade II** won first Prize of **Rs. 51,000** & a certificate for slogan writing competition on “Saving Planet through Sustainable Development Goals”
- ★ **Aradhya Garg** Grade VI bagged 4th position at National Level in the online Quiz based on the theme **FESTIVALS OF INDIA** which was organised by **ZEE TV MINDWARS**
- ★ Dakshesh Garg Grade IV won first place in a national online quiz competition with a solar system theme and received an e-certificate and an Amazon gift card as a prize from Zed TV.

Our 7 students won Gold Medals and Certificates at the SOF International English Olympiad in December 2022.

- ★ 17 Gold Medals Were won by students in the SOF Maths Olympiad in February 2022

4 Students of class 3 procured Gold medal in SOF International General Knowledge Olympiad held in the month of November.

SPORTS FIELD

They say "All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy." GAV encourages students to take part in sports and games that are physically active. The school competed in a number of competitions in 2022–2023, adding feathers to its cap. These competitions included the DPSG Cup, National Inter District Tournaments bringing two silvers, and Kids Athletics Federation of India and won 17 medals , which were held at Mahamaya Stadium in Ghaziabad.



- **Inter-House events**

We care about our students' overall well-being and encourage them to participate in a range of sporting events. The school organised basketball, volleyball, cricket, and football matches amongst the houses, in which students competed with zest and enthusiasm, bringing honours to their respective houses.

- ❖ Students participated in an Inter-house dancing competition, performing to a variety of music. Indian traditional music and dance were the main attractions of the event. Three categories in which the four houses—Pavak, Vasudha, Neer, and Gagan—competed. Each of the ancient dance forms, The vivid regional and traditional costume enhanced and accentuated the actions and expressions on the face of the participants.



- ❖ On the occasion of Diwali, activities involving Rangoli creation were undertaken. Students added brilliant colours with all of their creativity.

- ❖ Learners at GAV had a great idea of constructing their nutrition plates which helped them grasp the benefits of eating a balanced diet. Unhealthy foods may encounter growth and developmental difficulties, and poor academic performance.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS PROGRAMS / SPECIAL ASSEMBLIES

- ❖ The school presented a variety of interesting assemblies to enlighten students and faculty about important events occurring in their neighbourhood. International Girl Child Day, Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions Day, Water Conservation Day The assemblies for children covered themes including energy efficiency in both production and consumption, as well as ozone layer protection. Numerous Festivals were celebrated, with a focus on fostering peace and harmony.



- ❖ Saving water is one of the best practices which students can develop early. Numerous strategies for water conservation were put on display by the students. Through items, posters, and slogans, they were taught about the importance and uses for water.

CULTURAL REPORT

The first Annual Day, with the theme "**DHAROHAR**," was celebrated with great joy by the Gyan Anant Vidyalaya family. The legacy we leave for future generations—a healthy environment and a modest way of life—is what we refer to as our true heritage, or Dharohar.

The celebration was further enhanced by the presence of Mr. Pradip Burman, the founder and director of GAV and a philanthropist and sustainability crusader, and Ms. Indira Burman, who served as the chief guest.

Students from kindergarten to eighth grade performed a play titled "Noah" that focused on the importance of gender equality, safe water and sanitation, and quality education in the classroom.



SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- ❖ The school hosted a blood donation camp. where everyone actively participated and stepped out to support the noble cause.



- ❖ Students organised a rally and took a round to the neighbourhood as part of the 'Swachh Bharat-Swachhata Abhiyaan's' cleanliness campaign to raise awareness and encourage people to keep their surroundings clean.

ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMS/ ASSEMBLIES

AWARENESS

- ❖ One of the best habits children can form at a young age is saving water. Students of classes 1 and 2 participated in a "Save Water" programme. They demonstrated numerous methods for conserving water for the future. Students lectured about saving water, They taught about the value and applications of water through objects, posters and slogans.

MOTHER'S DAY

- ❖ GAV strongly believes in teaching moral values in students and is conscious of the value of interpersonal relationships in this process. Mother's Day was cheerfully observed at Gyan Anant Vidyalaya. The pupils were able to connect with one another because they openly communicated their emotions, regardless of their age, culture, or gender.



WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

- ❖ World Environment Day has served as a forum for bringing attention to environmental problems such as wildlife crime, overpopulation, global warming, and marine pollution. Gyan Anant Vidyalaya Atrouli students focused their efforts on finding the causes of various types of pollution, getting to the root of the problem, and raising public awareness about how to reduce environmental pollution, appreciate nature, preserve it, and conserve it on June 5 this year. Students were given different sustainable development goals and worked to find these causes.

SUMMER CAMP

❖ A summer camp was undertaken at Gyan Anant Vidyalaya, to channelize the energy of young learners towards experimenting and creating. Activities like storytelling, arts and crafts, flameless cooking, table etiquettes, best out of waste, busy brains, music, dance, DIY clay modelling gave them hands-on learning experiences .The excitement was equally visible in interactive sessions of yoga, meditation, aerobics and Zumba.The summer camp boosted the learners morale through various fun activities.



YOGA DAY

- ❖ The 8th International Yoga Day was observed at Gyan Anant Vidyalaya Atrouli with the theme "Yoga for Humanity." During an online event, the teachers and kids at the school participated in a variety of asanas and pranayamas. Parents, teachers, and students all took part in this activity with enthusiasm. In this course, numerous asanas were practised. In order to continually raise consciousness, the heart, mind, and body were all used; "yoga" was felt in the purest form.

STAFF/ STUDENTS ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES

We encourage both our teachers and students to stay current with current events since we think that learning is a lifelong process. Through workshops and seminars, GAV management has always endorsed and maintained a culture of interaction among its faculty and the student body.

- ❖ A workshop on "Educators for life; Celebrating excellence in Education" was attended by certain teachers from our school at Shiv Nadar School in Gurugram.
- ❖ Several IT training workshops were organised to train the teaching staff.
- ❖ An Indian expert on nest building, Mr Rakesh Khatri, paid a visit to our school, held a workshop, and informed the pupils on how to build a nest.



- ❖ Children at GAV engaged in a learning activity about appropriate and inappropriate touching as part of the course. This game was developed to increase awareness among our young children so they can better defend themselves from various forms of maltreatment. At school, young students are taught a variety of safety measures.
- ❖ A "bonding" session was held in the school to foster familiarity and ties between the pupils. This practice was designed to increase trust, enhance teamwork and communication, and sharpen problem-solving abilities. It increased their motivation and inventiveness.



- ❖ A workshop on managing menstruation health was held at the school. The session was jointly attended by 45 girls from Gav and Naveen Rajkiya vidyalaya.

COMPOSITE LAB

Spacious and well equipped integrated science laboratory having all features i.e. Models, Specimens, displays racks and boards , Learning kits, Charts, Audio-visual equipment, Chemical storage etc. helping teachers to demonstrate , validate and establish various phenomena, and facilitate learners to verify theories and relate fundamental principles and concepts.



MATHS LAB

- ❖ The mathematics lab, which is furnished with all contemporary amenities, has proven to be highly beneficial to the pupils. They are better equipped to remember and apply the information they learn.

LIBRARY

- ❖ GAV has a fully accessible state of the art fully electronic library with more than 2000 English and Hindi fiction, e-journals, magazines, online public access catalogues, e-books, and CD's etc.catering to the needs of the students.



CBSE AFFILIATION

- ❖ The school has made a commitment to giving students an improved education up to classes X and XII . This endeavour was an application for affiliation with CBSE BOARD. Furthermore, on November 19th, Part A of this was completed. Our affiliation was granted on March 30th after we completed this course successfully.
